
## Manaaki New Zealand Scholarships Programme (MNZSP) Logo

- The New Zealand Scholarships programme offers up to 597 tertiary scholarships and 230 short-term training annually to 112 countries.
- In Indonesia, up to 45 postgraduates and up to 100 short-term training scholarships are offered annually

# ELTO: English Language Training for Officials

- ELTO is Intensive English Language programme designed for Government Officials
- Up to 45 participants annually for Indonesia
- NZELTO regular course (4.5-5.5 IELTS range) up to 4 months
- NZ ELTO advance up to 3 months (5.5-6.5 IELTS range)
- Various topics; Agriculture; Education; Good Governance;
   Trade; and International Security Trends
- Fully funded
- This programme is run by Wellington Uni-Professional (WUPL) and the English Language Institute (ELI) at Victoria University of Wellington (VUW..
- Application through Ministry of State Secretariat website (Three intakes annually; Feb; May and Aug)\*



## **ELTO Overview**

- In-country pre-departure programme meetings
- New Zealand English Language Training Programme
  - 13 weeks full-time study in Wellington will include:
  - Comprehensive tailored English Language Training programme at the ELI, including language learning, intercultural communication, introduction to New Zealand and good governance
  - The course theme of Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security in an Era of Climate Change
  - Workplace communication and visits
  - A field trip
  - IELTS training and testing
  - Short breaks to recuperate or explore independently



## **ELTO Overview**

#### In-country workplace project

- Undertake a workplace-based project on the intake theme and prepare a 10-minute presentation.
- The teaching staff will lead online meetings to provide support and connect with other participants.

#### Southeast Asia Conference

- A three-day conference based around presenting the workplace projects which will provide engagement across cohorts.
- The conference will take place early in 2025 for Intakes 57, 58 and 59 in a Southeast Asian location.
- The workplace project needs to be completed to be eligible for the conference.



## **Selection Criteria**

- Individual applicants should meet the following criteria:
  - English language proficiency IELTS 4.5 5.5 or equivalent
  - Direct connection with the theme, preferably in a technical or policy role
  - Needs to use English frequently for work
  - Age range 25 45
  - If you have completed tertiary-level study in an English-speaking country, you are not eligible to apply for the NZELTO programme
- Applications are encouraged from:
  - Female candidates
  - Candidates from provincial centres who need to use English regularly in their work







## **Short Term Scholarships (STTS)**

- The STTS courses offer 4 to 6 week of courses to student Public Sector Leadership (PSL) Mid Level and Senior Leven Renewable Energy Project Management, Geotherma public health management, trade and good governance.
- Eligible participants are from the government, the privat sectors; academic and civil society organisation
- IELTS: 5.5
