JICA-DSP is a human resource development program that invites future leaders from partner countries to Japan to study in Master's or Doctor's courses at Japanese Universities.

It offers the participants opportunities to learn about Japan's development experience, which differs significantly from the history of growth and development found in the West.

It is being carried out by JICA as part of Official Development Assistance (ODA) by the Government of Japan



#### 2. Purpose of JICA-DSP




To develop future leaders in partner countries




### 8. Who can Apply?
